LESSON 4: WE CAN HELP ONE ANOTHER

Through this lesson children will learn that there are a lot of ways that children can help others in the community, whether it be at home, school or church.

TOPICS

Encouragement, Helping, Works

OPENING PRAYER AND PRAISE (5 minutes)

Praise and worship are an important part of a believer's life and children often learn best by watching and repeating what they see. So please, praise and worship together.

SCRIPTURE READING AND DISCUSSION (15 minutes)

Introduction:

In today's lesson, we will see that God helps us through difficult times. God also graciously uses us to help others, when they are in need.

Read 2 Corinthians 1:3-5

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Whom does this passage say is the "Father of compassion"? (God.)
- 2. Who comforts us in all our troubles? (God.)
- 3. How can we use the comfort we received from God to help comfort others? (We can share how God has helped us through similar problems. We can befriend them and pray for them. We can also share relative Bible passages with them.)

Read James 1:27

Discussion Questions:

- 1. What type of religion does God the Father accept as pure and faultless? (Those who look after orphans and widows that are in distress.)
- 2. Why is it important to look after those who are alone? (Allow for discussion.)

Read Romans 15:1-2

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Who is to bear the failings of the weak? (The strong.)
- 2. How should we lead our lives? (Not to please ourselves, but to help our neighbors.)
